The Role of Phonics and Grammar

Writing is a complex and challenging activity for many students. In order for students to become effective writers they need guidance in sentence formation, variety, usage and punctuation. Research shows that phonics and grammar instruction in isolation is not effective for the transfer of grammatical knowledge to written language. Instead, combining explicit instruction with students' writing can help them make immediate applications, thus allowing them to see the relevance of grammar to their own writing.

- In this workshop teachers will gain an understanding of best practice when teaching writing in the early years.
- The relevance of explicit phonics and grammar instruction will be highlighted together with strategies to assist students in connecting the phonics and grammatical knowledge to their writing.
- Teachers will gain hands-on, practical activities to explicitly teach grammar and how these can be incorporated into context of children's writing.
- Strategies to promote self-editing amongst students will be explored.

This full day course is aimed at Prep, Grade 1 and Grade 2 classroom teachers, support teachers and teacher aides.
