Materials Needed:

Noun Cards (found below)
Number Die

To Play

cut the cards individually and place in a pile faced down. Child rolls a die and picks up a card from the top of the pile. If numbers 1-5 are shown, child must come up with that number of adjectives to describe the noun on the card.

For eg if die shows number 3, the child must think of three adjectives for that word on the card. The child will be awarded three points if three adjectives are given; two points if only two adjectives are given etc. Each child keeps a tally of their score. If a 6 is rolled, that children loses all their accumulated points and begins at zero. First child to reach 20 points wins the game.
